Updating Software Version

- 1. Go to <u>http://www.clear.com/support/download</u> and navigate through the list of products to select the correct device. Verify if device has a recommended software installed
- 2. Download the new software to a location on the computer by selecting Firmware Update and Store
- 3. Connect to Device Home Page by typing <u>http://Puck</u> into the web browser
- 4. Enter the default password to gain Administrative rights. Navigate to the System tab and select Software from the dropdown menu
- 5. Click the MANUAL FIRMWARE UPLOAD button and navigate to the stored firmware file (ipk extension) on the computer
- 6. Select Factory Reset button and follow screen instruction
- 7. Once upgrade is complete, the device will automatically reboot
- 8. Verify the upgrade is successful by looking at the firmware version
- 9. Verify that the device can connect to Wi-Fi and CLEAR 4G network and access the Internet.
